What's going on in the arts in Singapore? Which are the main institutions and how do they influence the development of arts and culture? What differentiates one arts venue from another? How do arts presenters, venues, and funding agencies work with artists? What is commercial and what's not? How do our present arts and cultural venues & institutions relate to our historical and cultural traditions?

This workshop sends participants to explore the different museums, venues and institutions located in the central Arts & Heritage District. Armed with a map and a list of questions and clues, participants will be divided into groups to seek the answers and return to The Substation to share their findings with the other participants. There will be plenty of opportunity for discussion and debate. An artist will also be present to share his/her views.

Objectives & Learning Outcomes:

- * Develop students' understanding of the different roles played by museums, arts venues and other cultural institutions in Singapore
- * Expose students to the diversity of arts events in Singapore
- * Expose students to the range of jobs in the arts and culture industry
- * Enhance students' appreciation of Singapore's history and culture
